







# FULL STORY

## A VERY SPECIAL WELCOME

The 12-hour flight to Cape Town is rewarded by the minimal time difference making it a very doable 3-night incentive destination!. After an overnight flight and a late morning arrival, we're fresh and ready to head straight up to Signal Hill for a very special welcome. A Bedouin tent is set for a shady lunch, embracing magnificent views of Table Mountain and the whole of Cape Town. After lunch, we transfer to the V&A Waterfront where guests are greeted by the infamous Cape Minstrels, who lead us to the Table Bay Hotel. Situated on the beautiful V&A Waterfront, with bustling bars and shops on its doorstep and views from the bedrooms out over Table Mountain, this hotel is one of the best in Cape Town. A private check in is followed by some time to relax, before we head out for dinner. There is no better way to start the evening than with a private Champagne reception at the top of Table Mountain. As the sun sets, we transfer back down to the V&A Waterfront for an exclusive dinner at Baia where fabulous seafood and fine wines come as standard. Now that's what you call a good first day.

## STUNNING VIEWS OF THE COASTLINE

After a leisurely breakfast, we set off on a beautiful scenic drive along Chapman's Peak Drive towards the most Southernly point of South Africa. Here, we take the Cape Point Funicular up to the lighthouse for stunning views of the coastline and ocean.

Cocktails and a private BBQ buffet lunch awaits at Buffels Bay directly on the beach. Post feast there's time for more drinks, volleyball, or a swim in the sea for anyone brave enough! We return late afternoon with time for a dip in the pool, a drink in the bar or just to kick back and relax.

Dinner is taken privately at Camps Bay, at the fantastic beach view restaurant Bilboa (formerly Blues). After dinner, there's time to hit the beachfront bars before heading back to the hotel after another highly enjoyable day.

## WONDERFUL BUT EMOTIONAL EXPERIENCE

Robben Island plays a huge part in the history of South Africa, so it's here we spend the morning of day three. After a stroll around the waterfront, we ferry to the island where Nelson Mandela was once incarcerated and see first-hand the conditions prisoners were succumbed to. Lead by a former prisoner the tour is powerful, emotional and unforgettable.

Lunch is enjoyed back on the mainland at Harbour House Café where a seafood bonanza awaits. So fresh it almost walks off the plate and with an ice-cold glass of local Chardonnay to wash it down, this relaxed restaurant is a very nice way to spend a couple of hours before some time at leisure.

## GALA AT THE CASTLE

Dinner is held at the Castle of Good Hope, where guests are welcomed by Castle guards for drinks in the open-air courtyard to the sounds of a local marimba band. Fire poi perform on the walls of the castle before we take our seats for a gourmet dinner inside our clear span marquee with nature's starlit sky above.

## WINE TASTING IN BEAUTIFUL GARDENS

After a leisurely mid-morning check-out, we head to the winelands, stopping at Boschendal and Grand Provence to try some of the outstanding locally produced wines in their beautiful gardens. Our final wine-tasting is served at Haute Cabriere where a wonderful final lunch is enjoyed. After some time at leisure to enjoy a walk around Franschhoek, we head to the airport for our flight back to the UK..


