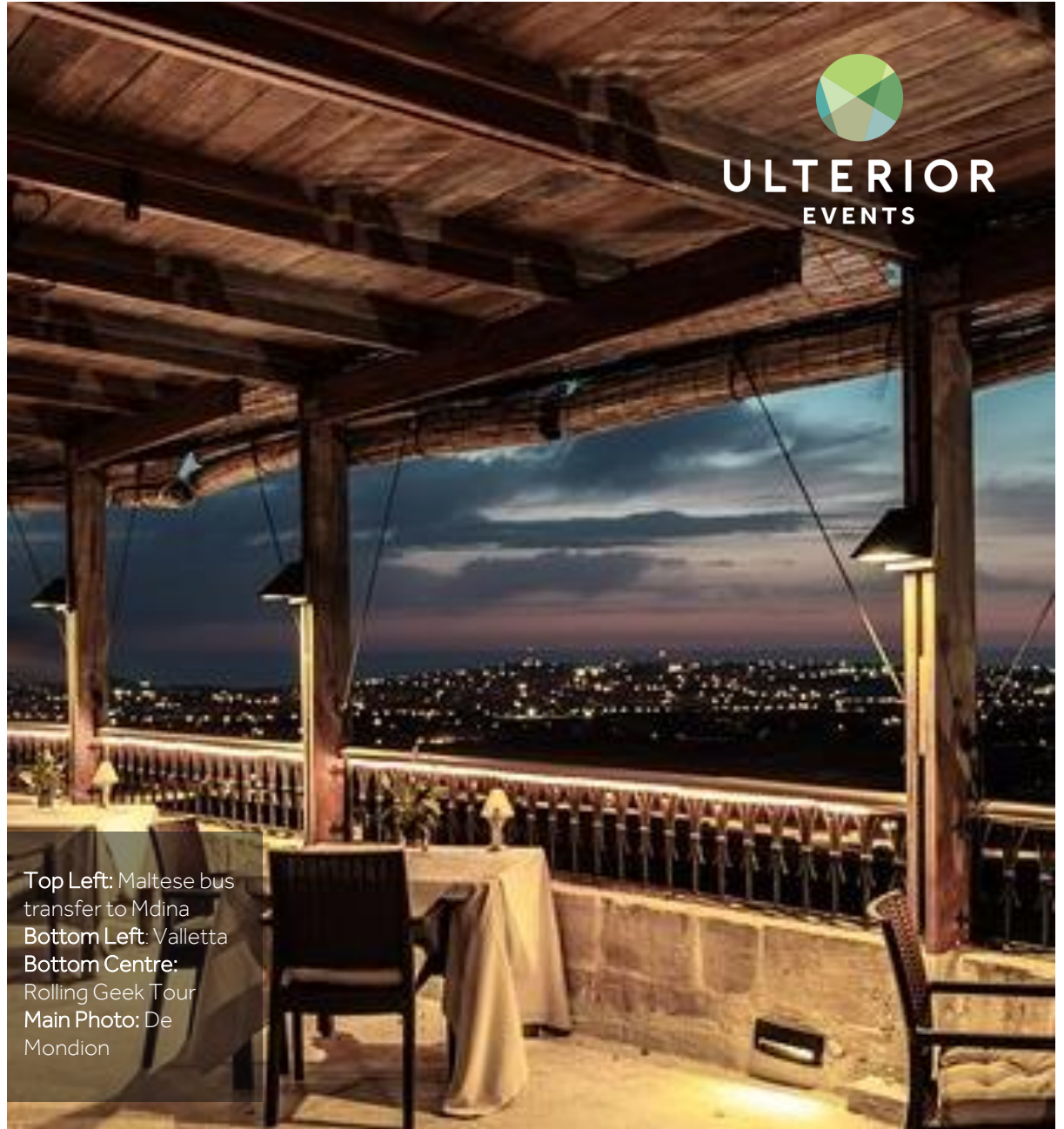

FULL STORY

A TASTE OF HISTORY

On arrival into Malta, we set off from the airport in style in colourful vintage cars, bound for the beautiful city of Birgu. Vehicles are flanked by stunning views as they cruise towards the city, before disembarking at Malta Maritime Museum, a former Royal Naval Bakery dating back to the 19th Century. A welcome glass of champagne is served on the terrace followed by an exclusive welcome lunch overlooking the harbour. Our menu today is the outcome of a professional team of curators and chefs coming together to recreate classic dishes – so we're sampling a real taste of history! Afterwards there's some time at leisure to explore the museum before heading to Birgu Harbour to board speedboats for a jet across the sea to the [Westin Dragonara Resort](#). The Westin Dragonara Resort is located in the exclusive sea-side enclave of St Julian's, perched on its own peninsula, with an oasis of luxury and tranquillity. We take a short walk to Caviar & Bull for dinner, which boasts striking views across St George's Bay and serves delicious Mediterranean cuisine. After dinner, guests can continue the night in some of the local bars around St Julian's before heading back to the hotel.

EXPLORATION OF VALLETTA

We meet for a private transfer to Valletta, the beautiful capital city of Malta and a world heritage site. Here we are met by hand-picked guides for a walking tour of the city, seeing and hearing about many of its famous landmarks including St Johns Co Cathedral, a gem of baroque art and architecture. The walking tour takes us to Upper Barrakka Gardens, which boast incredible views over Malta and the three cities within it. Local savoury pastries called pastizzis will be served along with

other delicious Maltese delicacies and a cold Cisk lager to wash it all down. From here it's a short walk to lunch at Pepe Nero, which is in one of the most picturesque areas of the island. The restaurant prides itself on offering a combination of the freshest ingredients and delicious flavours, with an exquisite menu featuring hand-stretched artisan pizzas, an array of meats, and market-fresh seafood. After lunch, we take a short private transfer back to the hotel for time at leisure. Then for our second evening, guests board colourful, vibrant vintage Maltese buses to transfer to Mdina. Lamp lit by night and referred to as the silent city, Mdina is fascinating to visit for its timeless atmosphere as well as its cultural and religious treasures. On arrival to Mdina, we take a short walking tour through the narrow streets, finishing at De Mondion for a private al fresco dinner on the terrace. This one Michelin star restaurant offers modern Mediterranean cuisine, combining the best locally sourced products with expertise to create tantalising dishes and a vast selection of wines to complement them. After dinner, guests can explore the local nightlife at leisure before heading back to the hotel.

DISCOVERY OF THE MAGICAL ISLAND

A day exploring Gozo is kicked off by an exhilarating speedboat transfer from the hotel jetty direct to the stunning island. Gozo is best known for its historic sites, forts, breath-taking views, and a richness of greenery, providing a tranquil haven for anyone visiting. On arrival, we board 4x4 open-top jeeps and begin our discovery of the magical island. Venturing East, we stop at several picturesque locations before arriving at Tal-Massar Winery for an early afternoon wine tasting accompanied by Maltese snacks. After, we jump back into our jeeps and continue the safari to the salt pans for a short stop before heading on to lunch at Country Terrace Restaurant. The restaurant, which offers local and Italian cuisine, and has wonderful views of the Mgarr Harbour and the surrounding

islands, is the perfect lunch stop after the morning adventure. After lunch, we return to Magarr Harbour by private transfer to board an impressive Turkish Gullet for a cruise back to Malta. Part way we drop anchor, to marvel at the crystal blue lagoon by Comino and for a dip in the ocean. Then it's back to the hotel for an afternoon at leisure. A farewell dinner is spent at Barracuda Restaurant, just a short transfer from the hotel. The restaurant is situated in a restored 18th century villa, stationed just over the water's edge, overlooking views of Balluta and Spinola Bay. Delicious fresh seafood and Mediterranean dishes are served as the sun sets over our final night.

THE ROLLING GEEKS ADVENTURE

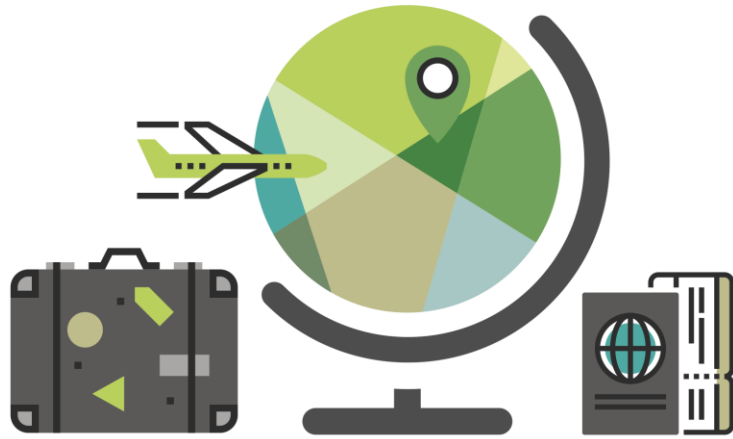
On checking out of the hotel, there's a private transfer into Birgu where we embark on a Rolling Geek tour through Birgu, Isla and Bormla. The Rolling Geeks are self-drive electric cars, complete with pre-programmed GPS that not only guide guests around the cities but also explain the history behind the amazing structures they pass along the way. After a morning of cruising, a farewell lunch will be served at Don Berto which is located on Birgu waterfront, with views of Malta's majestic Grand Harbour, before heading to the airport for the flight back to the UK.
