


Date	Morning	Noon	Night

CHAMPAGNE IN THE BLUE LAGOON

On arrival into Iceland, we immediately immerse ourselves in the intriguing rocky landscapes, heading directly to the famous Blue Lagoon for a spectacular geothermal spa experience. Located in a beautiful lava field, the blue lagoon allows guests to enjoy the radiant powers of geothermal sea water. After an exclusive VIP welcome through the dedicated entrance, we're greeted with fluffy white robes and towels, before slinking into the milk-blue water for a champagne reception. Our water waiters keep the drinks flowing, while we slip between floating spa beds for a relaxing treatment and bathe at leisure. After a couple of luxurious hours in the water, we change and head straight through to LAVA restaurant for a delicious lunch serving local Icelandic cuisine. Built into a stunning lava cliff overlooking the blue lagoon, it's the perfect location for lunch to complete the experience. After a morning of relaxation, it's time to head to the centre of Reykjavik for a private check-in at the Fosshotel – our home for the next two nights. With rooms overlooking the stunning south west coast, Fosshotel is only a stone's throw from the colourful city centre. After a short stroll to downtown Reykjavik, a three-course dinner is enjoyed at trendy Eiriksson Brasserie. Offering a delicious European menu with an Italian twist, fantastic wines and a great ambiance, the night ends on a high. Reykjavik has an abundance of (very) late bars that its easy to enjoy deep into the early hours.

GEYSERS ERUPTING AROUND THEM

Day two begins with a convoy of Super jeeps collecting us for an unforgettable day exploring the Golden Circle. With fantastic, knowledgeable guides on board, the group are buckled in and ready for an adrenaline-filled journey to Gullfoss Waterfall. As the first group arrive, it's straight to the highest viewing point to admire the frozen waterfall in all its beauty. A bubbly hot chocolate with the chill in the air only adds to the experience. Then it's back in our super jeeps for an exhilarating off-road journey to Haukadalur - one of Iceland's most famous historical sites known for its abundance of Geysers and hot springs. As the group jumped out of the jeeps, the Geysers spontaneously erupt around us! We stay long enough for photos and plenty of excited laughter before heading to a well-deserved lunch at Hotel Geyser, right on the doorstep of the geothermal region. Refreshed from lunch we head by super jeep to an incredible glacier, where a fleet of colourful snowmobiles await! Here, we take turns speeding across the bright white ice. Then as daylight fades to night, we head straight from the glacier to Fjorubordid for a delicious feast of langoustines and oversize beers set to the tune of local musicians.

BREATHTAKING VIEWS

What better way to begin our final day in Reykjavik than with a 2-seater buggy escapade along the foothills of Esja Mountain. Prepare to get wet while taking in the breath-taking views alongside! We whizz through rivers and streams and deep into the mountainous landscape before stopping for coffee and pastry After switching drivers and accelerating back to the base, it's time for a tasty farewell lunch.

BEER FLIGHT BEFORE THE REAL FLIGHT

Bryggjan Brughuss – the first independent microbrewery in Iceland – welcomes us for an exciting private tour of the brewery followed by a sumptuous lunch. Accompanied by a selection of beers brewed onsite we overlook the harbour, it's a great setting to relax in before departing back to London.
