A CHAMPAGNE CRUISE

Guests arrive into Stockholm late morning where they will board private coaches for a transfer to the city centre, stopping at the charming Stallmastaregården. On arrival, quests could be welcomed with a glass of Champagne on the terrace with stunning views overlooking the lake before heading into an exclusive lunch. With a gastronomic heritage and emphasis on traditional Swedish cuisine with a modern twist, this is a great way to start their time in Stockholm. After lunch, it's onto the iconic **Grand Hotel**. With elegantly designed rooms and the best waterfront location overlooking the Royal Palace and Old Town, it is the perfect place to stay for the next three nights. Following a private check in and time at leisure, guests can meet for a short walk before being welcomed onboard their private boat for a Champagne reception. After a 30-minute cruise along the archipelago, quests can disembark on the small island, Stora Fjaderholmen for a private welcome dinner at the popular Fjaderholmarnas Krog, a beautiful Swedish designed wooden restaurant located right on the waterfront and serving trendy local cuisine – a perfect setting for a first night dinner.

BREATHTAKING SCENERY

Today, guests are in for an exhilarating ride to discover the beautiful archipelago. With 8 Rib boats ready and waiting the group would embark on an adventure to the stunning Grinda Island, a nature reserve with a beautiful vista. As the boats speed across the water, guests will have views over the breathtaking scenery, passing by Nacka Strand, Gashaga and Vaxholm - the capital of the archipelago. Along the way the group stop at Byholmen island to enjoy a traditional

Swedish FIKA (coffee with sweet pastry), set up on the shoreline before continuing their journey to Grinda. On arrival, guests disembark and are led to the water's edge by the guide where a surprise is at the ready! As our local and knowledgeable guides inform guests of their surroundings, scuba divers emerge from the water with bottles of Champagne to welcome them onto the island. A private buffet lunch will be set in the garden of the Grinda Wardshus and guests will have time to enjoy the stunning setting, before heading back to the hotel by rib boats at a leisurely pace. This evening guests can meet for a short transfer to dinner at Grodan. Situated in a popular area of the city centre, this elegant banqueting hall designed in gold and white with silk tapestries and chandeliers, is the perfect location for a private dinner. After dinner, quest can enjoy the local nightlife or take a private transfer back to the hotel for a night cap in the hotel's popular Cadier bar. For those that would prefer a pleasant stroll, the hotel is only 20 minutes away.

DELICIOUS DELICACIES

After a relaxing buffet breakfast with views over the harbour, guests will set off on a walking tour with a twist. During the morning, guests would take in the beautiful city of Stockholm accompanied by our fantastic guides, with the chance to try some local specialties, including cinnamon rolls, reindeer and berries. It's then time to get their safety equipment on and climb to the top of the old Parliament building for a unique rooftop tour with magnificent panoramic views of the city - a great way to see Stockholm. After a wander through the picturesque square and narrow streets, the tour would finish at the enchanting Fem SmåHus (five houses) for lunch, an underground restaurant right in the heart of the historical Old Town. After lunch, guests can return to the hotel at leisure where they can enjoy the beautiful spa or have a glass of wine at the hotel's Grand Café overlooking the water. For their farewell gala evening it would only be right to hold a sumptuous banquet in the stunning Spegelsalen 'Hall of Mirrors' at the hotel, where the first Nobel Prize Ceremony

took place in 1901. This magnificent ballroom is beautifully decorated in gold, red and white with amazing paintings on the ceiling and huge chandeliers. With two long extravagantly decorated banquet tables lining the room, guests would enjoy a lavish meal, exquisite wine and excellent service whilst listening to the sounds of a Swedish classical trio. A night to remember and a perfect way to end the trip.

VIEWS ACROSS THE HARBOUR

Following a leisurely morning, guests would check out and meet for lunch. After a short stroll, guests would arrive at the charming and trendy Torpedverkstan Restaurant, the former torpedo workshop of the Swedish navy located at the quay line on Skeppsholmen's East side. With an open kitchen and windows facing out to the harbour, it's the perfect opportunity for guests to reminisce about the highlights over a glass of wine. A perfect place for a delicious light lunch before heading to the airport for their return flight home.
